
# **FREEZING TUITION**

COSTS LESS TODAY Than <u>in 2012</u>


# ROOM & BOARD


# VALUE

# **STUDENT DEBT**

- 59% OF BOILERMAKERS NOW GRADUATE DEBT-FREE, vs. the national average of 39%
- Financial literacy efforts and affordability initiatives REDUCED ANNUAL STUDENT BORROWING BY \$59 MILLION (2012-20)
- Total loan amounts are now BELOW 2003 LEVELS
- \$17.9 MILLION DISBURSED through nation's FIRST-OF-ITS-KIND Income Share Agreement, known as the Back a Boiler program, which has been utilized by 973 PURDUE STUDENTS FROM 150 MAJORS
- NEW BOILER AFFORDABILITY GRANT will cover remaining expenses after need-based aid for qualifying Indiana resident undergraduates, allowing them to graduate debt-free
